

Establishment of the Government and TEPCO's Mid-to-Long Term Countermeasure Meeting

December 16, 2011

Nuclear Emergency Response Headquarters

1. In accordance with the Step 2 Completion of the “Roadmap towards Restoration from the Accident at Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station, TEPCO,” the “Government and TEPCO's Mid-to-Long Term Countermeasure Meeting” will be newly established as a framework of cooperation between Government and TEPCO. This will decide the “Mid-and-long-Term Roadmap towards the Decommissioning of Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Units 1-4, TEPCO,” which provides a reasonable and specific process leading to completion of the decommissioning, and will manage progress of the roadmap, as well as maintain safety of the nuclear power station.

The Government-TEPCO Integrated Response Office will be abolished.
