Base Year 2005

Overview of Revision of Indices of Tertiary Industry Activity

I. Effect of Base Revision

In line with a report about revision of the base period, in principle, the base year has been changed every five years, and industrial classifications, adopted series and the seasonal adjustment method have been revised.

II. Points and Specific Contents of Base Revision

1. Points

- (1) Compliance with the new industrial classification
- (2) Change of the weight-calculation year
- (3) Revision of adopted series
- (4) Revision of monthly practices
- (5) Change of the seasonal adjustment method

2. Specific Contents

(1) Concept regarding Application of the New Industrial Classification

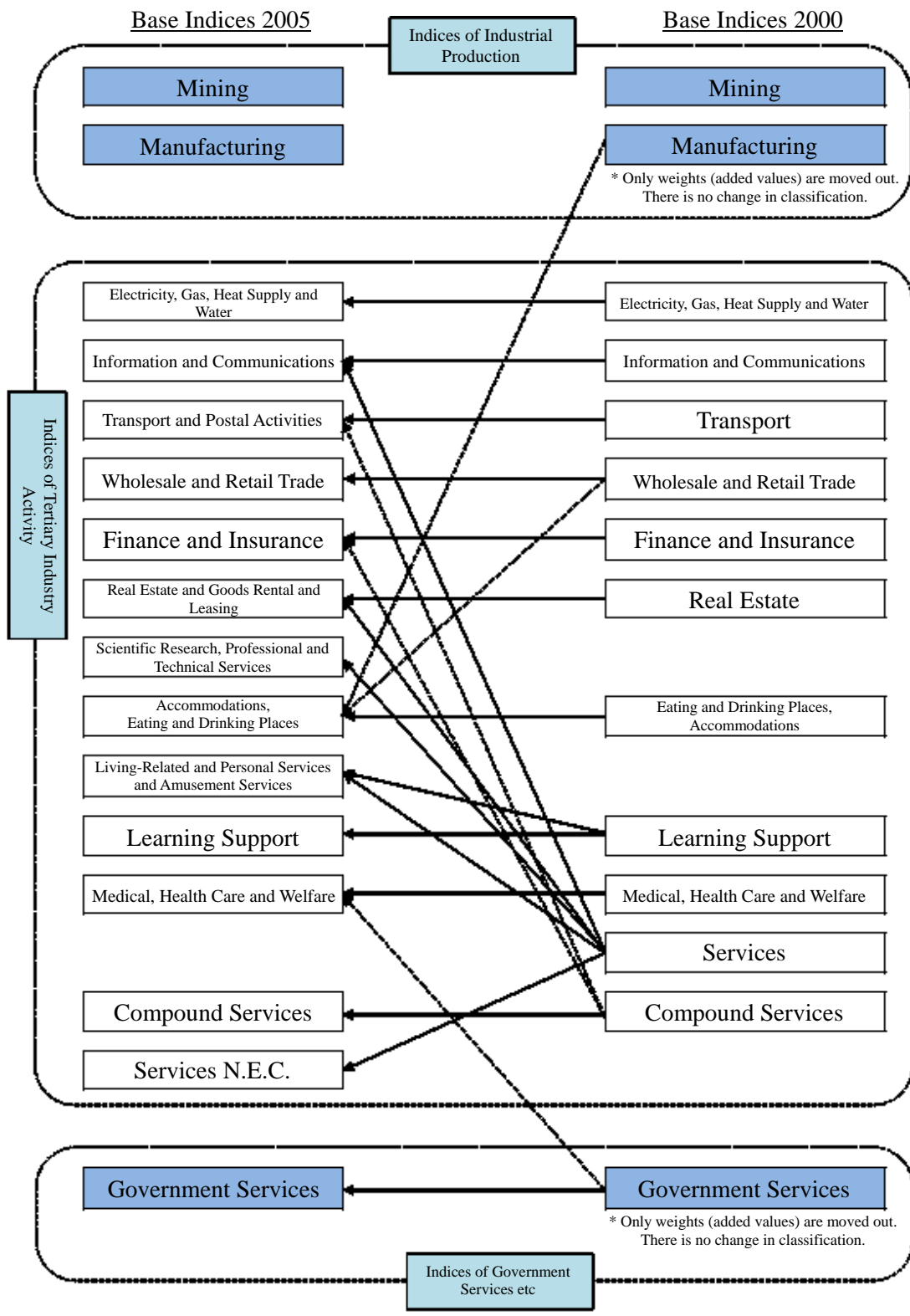
Industrial classifications have been changed basically in compliance with the Japan Standard Industrial Classification (JSIC) applied from April 2008. However, although the Divisions are split into the same 13 classifications as JSIC, the further subdivisions of Major groups, Groups and Industries are not fully in accord due to limitations on the adopted series, etc. In addition, from the perspective of continuity with base year 2000, special Major groups that are not included in JSIC (such as Passenger Transport) have been established.

As for changes to industrial classifications (Division base) in the Indices of Tertiary Industry Activity from base year 2000 to 2005, refer to Table 1. As for the correspondence table by Division, refer to Appendix Table 2.

(2) Calculation of Weights

- (i) Upon revision of the calculation year from 2000 to 2005, weights are calculated based on the added values in the 2005 Input-Output Tables for Japan (Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications).
- (ii) In accordance with the revision of the Japan Standard Industrial Classification (JSIC), the added values in the Input-Output Tables for Japan have been reclassified.
- (iii) Weights by Divisions in the Indices of Tertiary Industry Activity are as shown in Table 2. As for the detailed weights, refer to Appendix Table 3.

(3) Revision of Adopted Series

In this base revision, adopted individual series have been revised, and new series have been adopted by making an effort to find new available data in order to ensure representation that corresponds to the new industrial classifications.

As a result, the number of terminal series was increased from 156 in base year 2000 to 167 (including 1 special series) in base year 2005. As for the details of adopted data, refer to Appendix Table 1.

(4) Change to 3-Month-Practices (Extension of Retrospective Period for Revised Data: Up to 2 Months Earlier)

Since there are series that adopt the values found in corporate quarterly financial reports, monthly practices are changed from the current 2-month-practices (data for the recent month: preliminary report, data for the last month: revised report) to 3-month-practices (changes to data are made up to the month before last) through extension of the retrospective period for revised data (made known through notes in published materials).

(5) Regarding the Seasonal Adjustment Method

(i) As for the seasonal adjustment method, U.S. Census Bureau's X-12-ARIMA is adopted. ARIMA models and options have been revised. Major changes from base year 2000 are as follows.

i The ARIMA model has been changed from a single specification to multiple specifications.

ii The leap year adjustment method has been changed from removal by preadjustment to that of using regression variables.

iii Formations of predicted series have been changed from non-adoption to adoption (14 times).

iv The period of original series data to be seasonally adjusted has been changed from 7 years (84 times) to 8 years (96 times).

(ii) Method

Seasonally Adjusted Indices in the Indices of Tertiary Industry Activity are adjusted not only for seasonal effects, but also for the trading day and holiday effects and the leap year effects

The specific method is as follows.

Seasonal adjustment index = Original index ÷ (Seasonal, trading day, holiday and leap year indices)

(iii) Employment of seasonal index, etc.

The predicted values calculated according to the specifications listed in (iv) below are adopted for the seasonal index after January 2009. The trading day, holiday and leap year indices are calculated from the estimated parameters in (iv) below and the calendar.

(iv) Specifications

The specifications are as follows.

III. Regarding the link to the old base index

Since the industrial classifications in the Indices of Tertiary Industry Activity have been changed significantly in accordance with the revision of the Japan Standard Industrial Classification, some major series have become unlinked to the base indices 2000. However, as for the series that require linking to the existing classifications, as well as the linkable series, they will be linked to the base indices 2000 by the existing method of calculating the link coefficient as of 2003, through the establishment of special classifications.

The method of calculating the link coefficient used to link to the base indices 2000 is as follows.

$$\text{Link coefficient} = \frac{\text{Average seasonally adjusted index for January to March 2003 in the base indices 2005}}{\text{Average seasonally adjusted index for January to March 2003 in the base indices 2000}}$$
