〈Background〉

〈Outline and Objective〉

- By digitizing and putting villages online, farmers will be able to create “Smart Villages” where they can use digital services such as video viewing, telemedicine, and tele education.

Future Vision

The project will be introduced to rural villages throughout Benin. At the same time, the project will promote employment opportunities in Benin, especially in rural areas where employment opportunities are scarce, and establish a system to introduce the system to more villages throughout Benin.

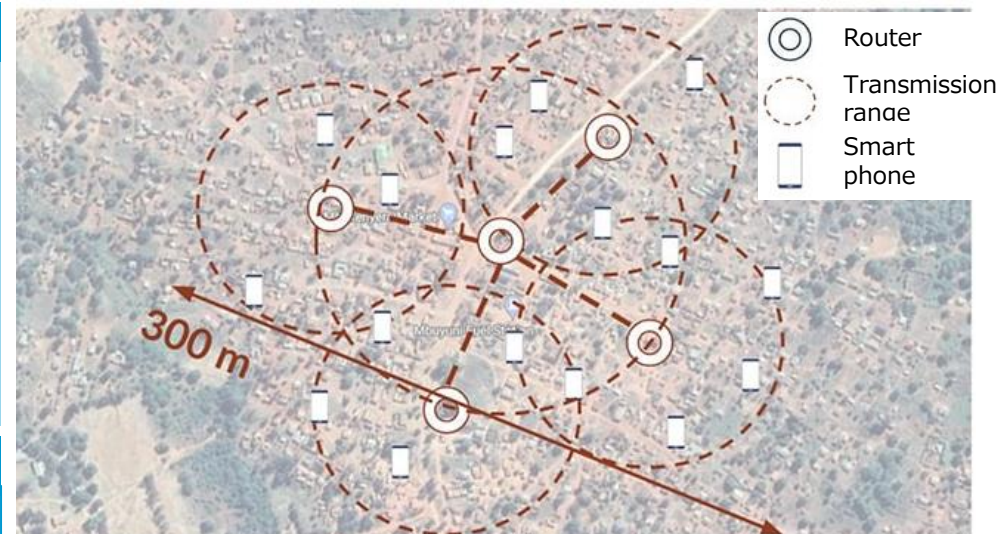
The company also plans to expand the system to 20 countries, mainly in West Africa, by 2030.
