

Japan's Export and Import measures against Russia and Belarus (Overview)

Export prohibition

- (1) Listed items in the multilateral export control regimes (Russia and Belarus) [Enforced on 18 March 2022]
* Dual-use goods such as machine tools, carbon fibers, high-performance, semiconductors, and their technologies
- (2) Unlisted dual-use items which could be considered for the development of military capacity (Russia and Belarus)
* General Dual-use goods such as semiconductors, computers, telecommunication equipment, and their technologies
[Enforced on 18 March 2022][Items added on 3 February 2023]
- (3) Items related to chemical and biological weapons(Russia) [Enforced on 7 October 2022][Items added on 3 February 2023]
* Substances for raw materials of chemical weapon agents and Equipment for production of chemical weapon agents and biological agents
- (4) Export prohibition to military-related entities (Russia and Belarus) [Enforced on 18 March 2022][80 Russian entities added on 2 June 2023]
* Russian 437 entities such as Ministry of Defense of Russia or Russian aircraft manufacturer, and Belarusian 27 entities
- (5) Items related to the development of advanced technology (Russia) [Enforced on 20 May 2022]
* Items such as quantum computers, additive manufacturing equipment, and their technologies
- (6) Items which could contribute to the enhancement of Russian industrial capacities to Russia
* Items such as dump trucks, bulldozers, vehicles of a cylinder capacity exceeding 1,900cc, hybrid passenger vehicles
[Enforced on 17 June 2022] [Items added on 9 August 2023]
- (7) Items related to oil refinery (Russia) [Enforced on 18 March 2022][Items added on 20 May 2022]
- (8) Luxury goods (Russia)
* Items such as luxury cars, jewelry [Enforced on 5 April 2022]

Import prohibition

- (9) Certain goods from Russia [Enforced on 19 April 2022][Added on 6 February 2023]
* Alcoholic beverages, woods, electric machinery, crude oil and petroleum products above the price cap

Export and Import prohibition

- (10) Exports and imports bans with the self-proclaimed "Donetsk People's Republic (DPR)" and "Luhansk People's Republic (LPR)." [Enforced on 26 February 2022 (Import) and on 18 March 2022 (Export)]
