- The US proposed the FMC initiative at COP26 as a way to <u>decarbonize the industrial sector and create a market for doing so</u>. Special Presidential Envoy Kerry and the WEF collaborated to launch the platform, as a way for <u>major global companies to commit to buying the technologies needed</u> to achieve net zero emissions by 2050 and start creating a market for them.
- The FMC will also partner with <u>Breakthrough Energy</u>, and the two will work together on market creation and financing.

First Movers Coalition (FMC)

- Special Presidential Envoy Kerry and the WEF collaborated to launch the platform at COP26, as a way for <u>major global companies to</u> <u>commit to buying the technologies needed</u> to achieve net zero emissions by 2050 and <u>start creating a market for them</u>.
