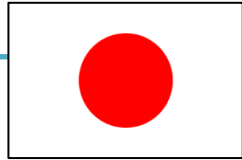


Cooperation between Japan and Malaysia on the Aircraft Industry

- Conditions in the aircraft industry are currently severe, but it will see continuing growth once demand for air travel recovers. Asia's global share is rising.
- Looking ahead to the world after COVID-19, Japan will strengthen its partnership with Malaysia, which has positioned developing its aircraft industry as a national strategy. The aim will be to support Japanese companies' efforts to cooperate with overseas companies, and expand their overseas sales channels and their supply chains in Asia.
