


To Exporters

Is the origin correctly indicated?

False indication of origin is a violation of the Import and Export Transaction Law!



There are various risks in false origin labeling

Examples of Risks

- Suspension of exports for up to one year
- Reprimand and advice
- Publication of penalty
- Relationships with partners and financial institutions
- Government Investigations



- 1. If a false indication of origin is found, METI will contact you (and may request a mandatory report).
- 2. The export of goods may be suspended for up to one year, with the item or destination to be determined.
- 3. The business may be exposed to significant risks in relation to government authorities, financial institutions, and business partners.
