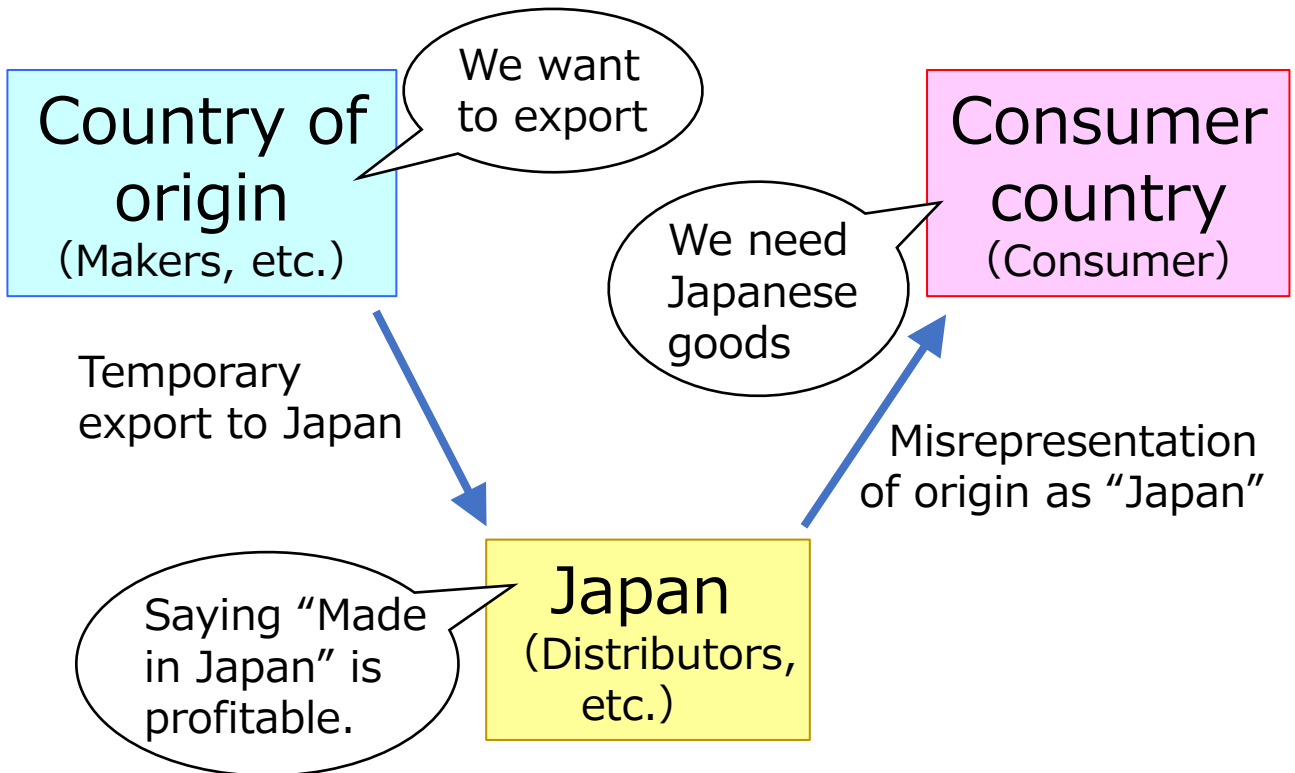


Is the **origin** correctly indicated?

False indication of origin is a violation of the Import and Export Transaction Law !



There are various risks in false origin labeling

Examples of Risks

- Suspension of exports for up to one year
- Reprimand and advice
- Publication of penalty
- Relationships with partners and financial institutions
- Government Investigations



1. If a false indication of origin is found, **METI will contact you** (and may request a mandatory report).
2. The export of goods may be **suspended for up to one year**, with the item or destination to be determined.
3. The business may be **exposed to significant risks** in relation to government authorities, financial institutions, and business partners.
