

Status of Response to Aviation Fuel Supply Shortages



(As of 4th meeting :26 September 2024)

Increase in supply

- After the task force meetings, efforts by oil wholesalers and trading companies have secured a supply plan of over 200 flights per week, exceeding the initial target of 150 flights per week.

Status of flights in service/increase in number of flights

- A total of 124 flights per week are now set to begin operations or increase frequency with the fuel supply secured.
- The 140 flights per week that were not in service or increased as of the announcement of the action plan in July of this year have been reduced to 16 flights per week.
- Because of additional flight requests, there are a total of 63 flights per week that have not yet been put into service or increased in frequency. We will continue to work to ensure a stable supply of aviation fuel.
