Status of Response to Aviation Fuel Supply Shortages

(As of 4th meeting :26 September 2024)

Increase in supply

 After the task force meetings, efforts by oil wholesalers and trading companies have secured a supply plan of over 200 flights per week, exceeding the initial target of 150 flights per week.

Status of flights in service/increase in number of flights

- A total of <u>124 flights per week</u> are now set to begin operations or increase frequency with the fuel supply secured.
- <u>The 140 flights per week</u> that were not in service or increased as of the announcement of the action plan in July of this year <u>have been reduced to 16 flights</u> <u>per week</u>.
- Because of additional flight requests, there are a total of 63 flights per week that have not yet been put into service or increased in frequency. We will <u>continue to</u> work to ensure a stable supply of aviation fuel.
