
Reconstruction Status of Textile Companies in Ishikawa Prefecture after 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake



- Textile companies in the Hokuriku region were affected by the Noto Peninsula Earthquake in January 2024. Even <u>textile companies in Ishikawa Prefecture, which was particularly affected by the</u> <u>earthquake, major companies resumed operations in about a week</u>.
- 157 textile companies in Ishikawa Prefecture, more than half of the companies affiliated with the prefectural textile association, were affected by the disaster, but <u>more than 90% of them (142</u> <u>companies) had resumed operation by the end of February</u>. Although some companies have not been able to resume operations due to building collapses, the supply chain has not been affected.
- At the Tokyo International Gift Show held in February 2024, the textile companies that were affected by the disaster exhibited as planned. <u>The reconstruction process is going well and active sales</u> <u>activities are underway.</u>
